

AGENDA PROCEDURES

A. **Quorum:** A majority of the members of the Board of Commissioners shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of the ordinary business of the County, and questions which arise at meetings shall be determined by the votes of a majority of the members present, except upon the final passage or adoption of a Measure of Resolution, or the allowance of a claim against the County, in which case a majority of the members elected and serving shall be necessary.

B. **ORDER OF BUSINESS:**

1. **AGENDA FOR REGULAR MEETINGS**

The Clerk of the Board, after first reviewing pending matters and requests with the Chair, shall prepare the agenda of business for all regularly scheduled commission meetings. Any Commissioner, Chair of a Committee, Board, or other Commission of the County, desiring to place a matter on the agenda shall notify the Clerk of such item by **9:00 A.M. FRIDAY** preceding the next regular meeting of the Board. If there is a holiday which falls on that Friday, agenda items shall be due on the preceding Thursday. Items not received by the Clerk of the Board by the stated deadline shall not be considered by the Board except upon the unanimous consent of the members present.

- (D) Roll Call

2. **AGENDA FOR SPECIAL MEETINGS**

Whenever the Board shall be called into special session, the agenda shall include any business of the Board if approved by the majority of the members present.

BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

The Board of Commissioners is the governing board and policy-making body of County government. While many of its powers, duties and responsibilities are prescribed by law, and diffused through the wide-spread use of commissions, boards, committees and independently elected county officers, the Board is in charge of developing and approving County policy, which includes setting the County budget.

The seven Commissioners are elected to two-year terms on a partisan basis from single-member districts. Regular sessions of the Board are on the second and fourth Wednesday of each month, at 9:30 a.m., and at such other times and days as may be established. Board meetings are held in the Commissioners' Meeting Room in the County Offices Building at 1087 E. Newell Street, White Cloud.

BOARD OF CANVASSERS

The Board is comprised of two Democrats and two Republicans. The political parties submit names of (3) persons by September 1 of each odd numbered year for nomination to the Board. The appointments are four-year terms and are made by the Board of Commissioners. Canvassers are responsible for reviewing election returns for all national, state and local offices, and school boards. The Board is also responsible for conducting recounts for all units of government in the County. Administration is provided by the Office of the County Clerk.

The Organizational meeting of the Board of County Canvassers shall be called by the County Clerk and shall be held in January of each even numbered year.

BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS

The Board was created by authority of Act 185, P.A. of 1957. This legal entity is necessary to borrow money and enter into contracts. Action of the B.P.W. is subject to the approval of the Board of Commissioners. The Board has authority to acquire, approve, expand, operate and maintain water and sewage supply, sewage disposal, solid waste management, lake improvements and erosion control systems. The Board of Public Works has within its duties the establishment of solid waste management programs, resource recovery, recycling, and public education.

BUILDING AND GROUNDS DEPARTMENT

Responsible for the maintenance and custodial services for all county-owned buildings and grounds. The supervisor is under the direction of the county administrator.

COUNTY ADMINISTRATION

Main activities assigned to the Administrator's position are to advance the coordination of County activities and provide financial management (budget, auditing, accounting). In addition, the Administrator supervises Building and Grounds, Commission on Aging, Community Development, Emergency Services, Equalization, Building Inspector, Mapping/GIS, and Information Technology.

CIRCUIT COURT

Circuit Court of Newaygo County is the trial court of general jurisdiction for the 27th Judicial Circuit of Michigan. It is the court of original jurisdiction for all civil actions, claims and remedies arising within the County, except for matters handled by courts of limited jurisdiction - District and Probate Courts - to which it acts as an appellate court.

Circuit Court has jurisdiction over civil cases in controversy of \$25,000 or more and cases involving title to land. Court hears divorce, child support, paternity cases, and all matters of the Family Division of the Circuit Court.

Criminal matters for Newaygo County involving charges carrying a maximum sentence of one year or more of imprisonment fall within its jurisdiction, including all felonies and Circuit Court misdemeanors.

Circuit Court is responsible for operation of Adult Probation, Friend of the Court, Jury Commission and County Law Library. Judges are elected for six-year terms on a staggered basis.

COUNTY CLERK

The County Clerk is an officer of the County as prescribed by State law. Michigan Constitution provides that voters of each county shall elect a Clerk, on a partisan basis, every four years. Duties are prescribed by law and include Clerk to the Newaygo County Board of Commissioners, Clerk to Circuit Court, Board of Canvassers, County Election Commission, County Plat Board, County Apportionment Board, County Tax Allocation Board, and Concealed Weapons Licensing Board.

The Clerk maintains birth and death records, marriage licenses, assumed business names and partnership certificates, concealed weapons permits, veteran discharge records, and voter registration records.

The County Clerk is the chief election official of the County, supervises all national, state, local, and school elections, and is responsible for the administration of the Michigan Campaign Finance Reporting Act.

CONCEALED WEAPONS LICENSING BOARD

The Board is comprised of representatives from the Prosecuting Attorney's Office, Sheriff's Department and Michigan State Police. The County Clerk serves as the Clerk of the Board. The Board is responsible for review and approval or disapproval of applications for concealed weapons permits.

M.S.U. EXTENSION SERVICE

With the passage of the Smith-Lever Act in 1914, M.S.U. Extension Service is an educational outreach arm of Michigan State University.

MSUE offers educational opportunities for citizens in the areas of agriculture and marketing, family and consumer sciences, 4-H youth programs, and natural resources and public policy. These programs are designed to help people better understand the world around them, use their resources more effectively and make wise decisions.

COMMISSION ON AGING

Newaygo County Commission on Aging was established in 1974 by the Board of Commissioners to address needs of Newaygo County residents age 60 and older. A ten member advisory board, appointed by the Board of Commissioners, assists in planning, implementation and monitoring of senior programs and services. The Commission is funded through federal and state grants, fraternal and social organizations, churches, client donations and a designated 1/2 mill of property tax.

The Newaygo County 78th District Court has jurisdiction in civil matters where the amount in controversy is less than \$25,000. In criminal matters it has jurisdiction over misdemeanors, ordinances and preliminary examination of all felony cases. Duties and powers formerly assigned to Justices of the Peace and Circuit Court Commissioners are now assigned to District Court.

DRAIN COMMISSIONER

The Drain Commissioner is elected by state law every four years on a partisan basis. The Drain Commissioner is responsible for administration of the Drain Code of 1956, as amended. Duties include construction and maintenance of drains, determining drainage district, apportioning costs of drains among property owners; receiving bids and awarding contracts.

Also serves as the County Enforcing Agent for the Soil Erosion and Sedimentation Control Program enforcing Part 91 of Act 451 of 1994, as amended (formerly P.A. 347 of 1972), and the Administrative Rules for all earth disturbances within 500 feet of a lake or stream, or the disturbance of one acre or more of land. Works with State and Federal agencies to enforce floodplain and pollution laws, assisting in coordinating regional flood control and water quality plans. Reviews and approves all plats, member of Board of Public Works, County Parks and Recreation Commission, all established Lake Improvement Boards and operation and maintenance of all established Lake Level Controls.

ELECTION COMMISSION

The Commission is comprised of the Presiding Judge of the Probate Court, the County Treasurer, and the County Clerk. The Commission is responsible for approval of ballot preparation for state and county elections, passes on the clarity of language in petitions to recall elected officials. Administration is provided by the County Clerk.

EMERGENCY SERVICES DEPARTMENT

The Department is responsible for dealing with the various aspects of disasters, including defining which major disasters might affect the County and coordinating the actual recovery efforts following actual disasters. The Department also provides educational programs to help the public deal with disasters. The Emergency Services Director is directly responsible to the Board of Commissioners.

EQUALIZATION DEPARTMENT

Under the direction of the Equalization Director, the department is responsible for preparation of the Equalization Report for the Board of Commissioners. The report is necessary to assure that tax assessments throughout Newaygo County are levied at comparable levels of market value. Duties are prescribed by law and also include preparation of the annual apportionment report and calculating to ascertain all required roll back requirements are met for all taxing jurisdictions within Newaygo County. This department is also responsible for maintaining Newaygo County property tax maps, processing land divisions, updating descriptions and property tax/assessment records for 24 townships, 4 cities and 1 village within the county.

FRIEND OF THE COURT

This agency is the investigative and enforcement arm of the Circuit Court in domestic relations involving minor children. The Friend of the Court enforces all Circuit Court orders relating to the custody of minor children, payment of support, and visitation rights of parents.

MEDICAL EXAMINER

The County Medical Examiner is mandated by law to establish the cause, manner and time of death, and identify persons who died suddenly, unexpectedly, violently, as a result of any suspicious circumstances, as a result of an abortion, while imprisoned in a county or city jail, or persons who died without medical attendance 48 hours prior to the time of death. The Medical Examiner is to establish the cause and manner of death when there is no other physician available or none willing to sign the death certificate. The Medical Examiner and Deputy Medical Examiner must be physicians and are assisted by investigative personnel.

PARKS COMMISSION

The County Parks and Recreation Commission, consisting of ten members, is created by State law. Responsible for administering the County Parks and recreational facilities. Director serves at the pleasure of the Parks Commission.

PLAT BOARD

The Board is created by State law and is comprised of the Register of Deeds, County Clerk and County Treasurer who serve as Chairman, Clerk and Member respectively. The Board is responsible for the examination and approval or disapproval of all proposed plats (or subdivisions) in the County.

PROBATE COURT

The Probate Court has jurisdiction in all matters relating to the settlement of estates, the execution of wills, appointment of guardians, commitment of persons determined mentally ill, and issuance of secret marriage licenses. The Judge of Probate also serves as the Family Division Judge of the 27th Circuit Court.

PROSECUTING ATTORNEY

The Prosecuting Attorney is elected on a partisan basis for a four-year term. The office is established according to the Michigan Constitution and is responsible for the prosecution of violations of state criminal law in the County. The Prosecutor is the Chief Law Enforcement Officer in the County and represents the County in all criminal matters before the District, Circuit, Appellate and Supreme Courts, as well as Federal Courts where the County is a party or has an interest.

REGISTER OF DEEDS

The Register of Deeds officially records legal papers and instruments (deeds, mortgages and plats) pertaining to the transfer and encumbrance of all lands and properties in the County. All duties are prescribed by State law. The Register of Deeds is an officer of the County as prescribed by State law and is elected every four years on a partisan basis. The Register serves as the Chairperson of the County Plat Board.

PERMITS AND INSPECTIONS

The County Surveyor is elected on a partisan basis every four years and must be a qualified surveyor. Duties include advising the County on matters for which the skills of a surveyor are required.

The County Treasurer is elected on a partisan basis every four years according to the Michigan Constitution. The treasurer is an officer of the County as prescribed by State law.

The treasurer is responsible for accounting of all revenue, investments, securities and monies in financial institutions and collection of delinquent property tax and inheritance tax for the State. Certification of deeds agent for disbursement of certain tax funds to local units of government and school districts. The treasurer is also responsible for the implementation of the tax reversion process for the county. Sells dog licenses. The treasurer is a member of County Election Commission, Plat Board, County Tax Allocation Board, and appointed Administrative Agent for Tax Administration Funds.

Within 60 days after the publication of the 2010 United States official decennial census figures the County Apportionment Commission shall apportion the county into not less than 5 nor more than 15 county commissioner districts as nearly equal in population as is practicable and within the limits of Section 2.

The 2011 apportionment commission reviewed numerous plans representing 5 member districts through 7 member districts.

The majority of the committee favored the 7-district plan. The adopted apportionment divides Brooks Township and the City of Fremont, providing for a population differential of 7.25% and meeting the constitutional equal population standards.

The 7 commissioner districts became effective January 1, 2013, and remain in effect through December 31, 2022.

NEWAYGO COUNTY HISTORY

The Ordinances of 1784, 1785, and the Northwest Ordinance of 1787 established the Land Survey system, which became the basis for future land development in the United States. The Land Survey System established the concept of the county government practiced today in Michigan. The Northwest Ordinance (1787) established 5 1/4 states: Illinois, Indiana, Michigan, Ohio, Wisconsin and part of Minnesota. The ordinance served as a governmental basis in those states. Thus, Newaygo County and its government are a product of the Northwest Ordinance of 1787.

Newaygo County was organized in 1851, and thought to be named for a Chippewa Chief, who was a signer of the Saginaw Treaty of 1819.

In 1928, Newaygo County was the first county to have a fall color tour.

One of West Michigan's most popular all-year vacation centers, Newaygo County features a winding network of large and small streams, many lakes, unexcelled scenic beauty and modern accommodations. There are 234 lakes, 356 miles of rivers and streams and hundreds of acres of beautifully wooded countryside to provide activities for all recreational interests.

Newaygo County is at the peak of its beauty during October, when nature stages its annual color show.

With the snow and ice of winter, the lure of Newaygo County is felt by those who enjoy outdoor sports such as cross country skiing and snowmobiling. Ice fishing is offered on the numerous lakes or the backwaters of Croton and Hardy Dams.
