

NEWAYGO COUNTY PARK RULES AND REGULATIONS

(Taken from Newaygo County Ordinance #95-ORD-001)

1. All campers must obtain permit before camping; No person shall occupy a site for which a fee is charged until the entire fee has been paid. **NO MORE THAN ONE UNIT ON A SITE.** (If you would like to place a tent on your lot in addition to your primary camping unit for your minor children, please check with staff!)
2. A campsite may be occupied by: (a) One family consisting of father and/or mother and unmarried children. (b) One group consisting of no more than eight individuals in one camping unit.
3. Checkout is 3:00 p.m. If you are not off the lot by 3:00 p.m. your items will be removed by the parks staff to allow for the next camper to set up.
4. Campers are to keep campsite neat. No can, bottles, trash, or other debris are to be put into fire rings or around camp unit. Place all refuse in dumpsters before leaving.
5. Waste water, on sites without sewer hookup, shall be drained into closed containers and emptied into dump stations.
6. Dogs shall be kept on a leash at all times. Pets are not allowed in swimming areas. No pets are allowed to be left unattended. Droppings are to be cleaned up at time of deposit. You must keep your pet quiet at all times. You will be held liable for your pet's behavior.
7. Quiet time is 11:00 PM to 7:00 AM. No loud music at any time.
8. Park shall not be liable for any loss or damage to trailers or other personal property by any cause whatsoever.
9. Sublet of trailer or campsite is forbidden.
10. All vehicles must have current Newaygo County Park's motor vehicle permit permanently ADHERED. Maximum of 2 vehicles per campsite.
11. No children are to be left at campsite without adult supervision (must be at least 18 years of age). No children will be allowed to be away from campsites after 10:00 p.m. unless accompanied by a responsible adult.
12. Lot marking posts and signs are put in for a purpose and are to be left alone. Anyone tampering with lot marking posts or signs will be asked to leave.
13. Guests must adhere to all park rules.
14. Visiting hours end at 10:00 PM, visitors are to leave by that time.

15. All vehicles and trailers must be parked within your own lot boundaries and aligned perpendicular to campground roads or in designated parking areas.
16. All park roads are public roadways, off road vehicles shall not be ridden in park. No person shall operate any non-road licensed motor driven vehicle on any park property.
17. Speed limit is 10 miles per hour in all park areas.
18. Once a lot is occupied, there will be no refund except as stated in Newaygo County Ordinance #95-ORD-001.
19. Absolutely NO fireworks (including sparklers).
20. No lifeguard on duty - SWIM AT YOUR OWN RISK.
21. No electrical wiring or extension cords shall be buried.
22. No private docks, decks, storage sheds, or similar structures shall be allowed on park property.

**ANY INFRACTION OF THESE RULES AND REGULATIONS
SHALL BE REASON FOR CAMPSITE EVICTION
AND/OR REMOVAL OF CAMPING UNIT AT OWNER'S EXPENSE.**

FURTHERMORE, IN ADDITION TO ANY ADMINISTRATIVE PENALTY PROVIDED FOR HEREIN, ANY PERSON VIOLATING ANY PROVISION OF THE FOREGOING RULES SHALL BE GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR AND UPON CONVICTION THEREOF SHALL BE FINED NOT MORE THAN \$100.00, AS WELL AS ORDERED TO PAY PROSECUTION AND COURT COSTS AND TO PAY FOR THE RESTITUTION OR REPAIR OF ANY DAMAGED PARK PROPERTY. ANY PERSON VIOLATING ANY PORTION OF ORDINANCE #95-ORD-001 MAY ALSO BE IMPRISONED IN THE COUNTY JAIL FOR A PERIOD NOT EXCEEDING 90 DAYS, IN THE DISCRETION OF THE COURT.
